Become a SEA Advocate today!

To become a SEA Advocate, there are three simple steps that must be met each year to qualify. Once achieved, a member of the SEA team will reach out directly to explain the benefits and how to exercise them.

- Annual Requirements:
 - 1. <u>DONATE</u>: Donate to one of SEA's organized Congressional fundraisers.
 - 2. <u>PARTICIPATE:</u> Attend one or more of SEA's events (Fly-Ins, Mar-a-Lago, Labor Forum and/or Fall Strategy Meeting).
 - 3. <u>ACTIVATE:</u> Respond to SEA's political calls to action (e.g., contact your member of Congress to ask him/her to sign letter to DHS requesting expedited visa release).
- Benefits:
 - 1. 15% off meeting registration fee for any SEA event attended
 - 2. Yearly gift
 - 3. Recognition on SEA website

To jump start the program, we will *grandfather in all members who have met the requirements for FY2025*. Please be on the lookout for follow-up communication.
